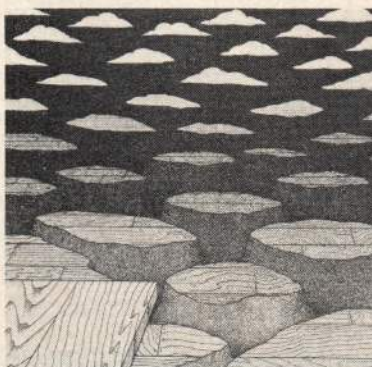
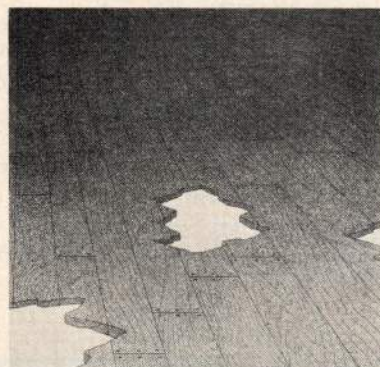
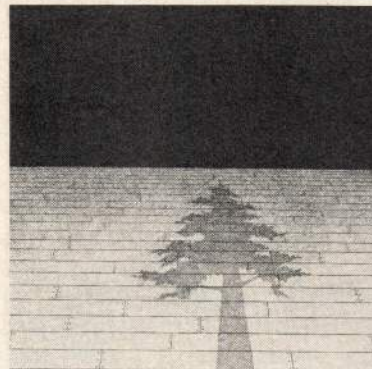
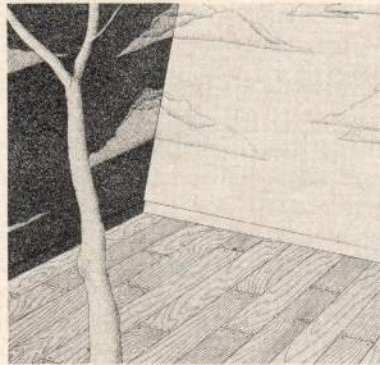

**Presentation House in North Vancouver will be showing "Fleeting Gestures: Treasures of Dance Photography,"** an exhibition drawn from a number of collections around the world. The work of 95 photographers including Edgar Degas, Edward Steichen, Imogen Cunningham and Cecil Beaton will be featured, and subjects include some of the most renowned figures in the history of dance. The only Canadian showing of this exhibition opens Oct. 8 at 8 p.m. and closes Sunday, November 29. Gallery hours are Wed. - Sun. 12:00 - 4:30 and Thursday evenings 7 - 9 p.m.
